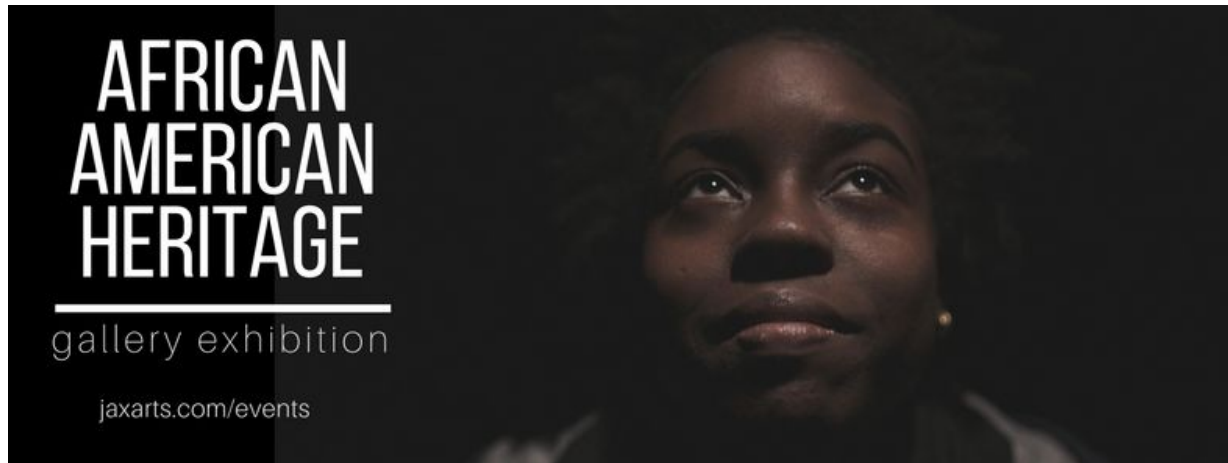

Artists are invited to drop off their creations for the event beginning January 15th, 2018, Tuesday-Friday from 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. The last day to submit works will be January 30th, 2018.

Submission Eligibility:

- All artists, ages 15 and up, from Onslow County and surrounding areas are invited to submit works to be considered for inclusion in this Gallery Exhibit.
- Works in any medium, including 3D and textile art, may be submitted for review by the Gallery Panel. *All submitted pieces may not be displayed in the final Gallery Exhibit.*
- The Gallery Panel will review all works of art submitted for
 - artistic quality and merit
 - show/theme relevance, and
 - to ensure the submissions meet the Gallery Standards below.

Gallery Standards:

- Each Artist may submit up to **5 original, ready to display** works of art for consideration.
- Original works are not duplicates. Reprints or reproductions will not be accepted.
- Pieces must be **wired** for hanging or submitted with display stands to be considered for inclusion in the Gallery Show.
- Works on stretched canvas must be framed or have finished/painted sides. Works on canvas board, paper or other such mediums must be framed.
- This is a family-friendly exhibit, pieces with profanity or nudity will not be accepted.

Gallery Sales Commissions:

- For non-members, the Council for the Arts will retain a 35% commission for each piece sold.
- For members, the Council for the Arts will retain a 25% commission for each piece sold.
